

LETTERS FROM ST PIERRE AND MIQUELON TO FOREIGN PLACES BEARING NEWFOUNDLAND STAMPS ARE MOST UNCOMMON. ST PIERRE RECEIVED ITS OWN ISSUE OF OVERPRINTED FRENCH STAMPS IN 1885. THE FRENCH COLONIAL STAMPS WERE IDENTIFIED BY A NEW VALUE AND THE INITIALS S.P.M. FROM THEN ON IDENTIFIED STAMPS WERE AVAILABLE TO THE LITTLE ISLANDS.

USED NEWFOUNDLAND STAMPS ARE KNOWN WITH DATESTAMPS USED AS A CANCEL FROM 1882 TO 1886.

ANY COMPLETE COVER FROM ST PIERRE, ESPECIALLY AT THIS LATE DATE IS QUITE A RARITY.

AN UNCOMMON USAGE, BUT UNDERSTANDABLE AS ST PIERRE HAD NO STAMPS OF THEIR OWN. NOT MANY CAN BE FOUND SO CANCELLED AND ONLY A FEW COVERS SURVIVED.

20,000 OF EACH OF FIVE VALUES WERE PRINTED IN JUNE 1895. THEY WERE FINALLY ISSUED TO THE PUBLIC IN JANUARY 1896, MANY OF THEM GOING INTO THE HANDS OF A STAMP DEALER. THEY APPEAR ON COVER ONLY OCCASIONALLY, MOST OF THE LETTERS BEING SENT TO FIRENDS.

AFTER THE 1¢ CABOT STAMPS AND THE 1897 OVERPRINTS WERE EXHAUSTED THE COLONIAL SECRETARY ORDERED THE 1¢ ROYAL ISSUE IN SEPTEMBER. STRANGELY THEREAFTER HE ALSO RE-ORDERED 150,000 1/2¢ BLACK, 100,000 1¢ GREEN AND 100,000 2¢ ORANGE S FROM THE BANK NOTE COMPANY ON 27 NOVEMBER. THE 400,000 RED 1¢ STAMPS OF THE ROYAL ISSUE WERE RECEIVED IN EARLY DECEMBER AND THE GREEN 1¢ COULD NOT HAVE ARRIVED UNTIL JANUARY 1898. THEY WERE NOT PART OF THE 1895 (OR 1896 IF YOU PR REPRINTS OF WHICH 20,000 EACH WERE PRINTED.



THE 2¢ 1895 REPRINT WITH A ((235)) CANCELLATION MUST HAVE BEEN CANCELLED TO ORDER. COVERS WITH THIS CANCELLATION CEASE IN MID 1887 SHORTLY AFTER FRAZER BECAME POSTMASTER GENERAL. THE DEVICE MUST HAVE REMAINED IN PRIVATE HANDS AND AVAILABLE TO SOMEONE KNOWLEDGEABLE ABOUT CANCELLATIONS IN 1896.
