#### WINTER MAIL SERVICE.

Persons from an inaccessible, the southern part of the most fertile of the Hecla. American government, is situated in the Gulf of St. Lawrence between the 42d and 43d degrees of latitude, and the east coast of Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, from which it is separated by the Strait of St. Lawrence, which is a narrow part. The telegraph cable crosses at this point, its terminal being at Capot Tormentose and Tormentose, the end of which is in New Brunswick. The mail of the winter mail service also lies between these two capes. There are few places more lightful or better worth a visit than Prince Edward Island, and it has recently become the resort of many American tourists. Two lines of fine steamers connect it with the adjacent Province of New Brunswick, across the harbor, vessels which are frequently loaded from the rest of the world for the conquest fields of ice or drifting ones that fill the Gulf of St. Lawrence. The largest merchant at home, the only one of importance which the inhabitants here with others is the ice-boat, which carries the mail across the Strait; three parties are employed in a party of a week. It is a vessel of 100 tons, and carries from four to five hundred passengers, according to the condition of the sea. Nevertheless, it is occasionally undertaken even by ladies. No baggage is allowed, and but two or three persons except the boatman can go at a time. Sometimes the surface of the ice is examined by long channels of open water. In other cases the journey is made with tolerable expedition. But in general the report is Arctic.
